#### **ENERGY AND TECHNOLOGY COMMITTEE:**

##### **Council Bill [116512](#) PASSED (9 – 0)**

This bill accepts the deeds to the Sjoboen and Wild Fish Conservancy properties in Skagit County for Salmon habitat protection purposes.

#### **FINANCE AND BUDGET COMMITTEE:**

##### **Council Bill [116515](#) PASSED (9 – 0)**

This bill authorizes the Fleets and Facilities department to lease a space at 600 at SW 39<sup>th</sup> street in Renton to be occupied by the Aging and Disability Services division.

##### **Resolution [31134](#) ADOPTED (9 – 0)**

This Resolution relates to the City's 2009 and 2010 budgets, acknowledging the need for immediate spending reductions and establishing the Council's highest priorities.
